Convention Bulletin

Midland, Michigan – Valley Plaza Resort - June 9th 10th 11th and 12th 2022

Madam Secretary – Please, read to your Auxiliary and keep, for reference.

The 74th Annual Convention of the Michigan State Auxiliary F.O.E. Headquarters will be at the Valley Plaza Resort, Midland, Michigan. The State Aerie and State Auxiliary will host the Convention as they have in the past. The Auxiliary will start registration on Wednesday, June 8, 2022 starting at 2:00 p.m. at the Convention Headquarters.

All the Convention Committee meeting room numbers will be posted at the Registration Desk. If you are asked by the State Madam President to serve on a committee, your meeting will be at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday. **NOTE: The Credential Committee will meet at 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 8, 2022 in the Commodore Room so the committee will be ready to open Registration to the Delegates and Members at 2:00 p.m.**

Delegates: The State Auxiliary by-laws allow each Auxiliary that has filed its required reports and **HAS PAID IT'S PER CAPITA TAX IN FULL** based on the June 2021 Annual report not including Dual Members – one (1) vote for each twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof. This means that if you are 13 more into the next 25 members your Auxiliary gets one more Auxiliary vote. This does not mean you must send a Delegate for each vote, as an Auxiliary delegate may carry as many as three (3) Auxiliary votes and if she is a PMP or TYS she gets one additional vote. If she is not an Auxiliary Delegate, but a Past Madam President or Ten Year Secretary and wishes to vote, she must register paying the required Registration fee. No registration changes in category will be permitted once registered. **NO SISTER MAY CARRY MORE THAN 3 AUXILIARY VOTES**, however if they are a Past Madam President or a Ten Year Secretary she would get one (1) additional vote and if she is also a State Officer or a Past State Madam President she would get one (1) more vote.

The credential sheets, **three (3)** for listing Auxiliary, delegates, and alternates and ALL Past Madam Presidents, are enclosed. Secretaries – please read the instructions before filling out the credential sheets. **DO NOT REDUCE THE DELEGATE SHEETS, AS THEY ARE USED FOR OUR REGISTRATION AND ELECTION BOOKS.**

List Auxiliary Delegates first, write the name of the delegate, then **D** for Auxiliary delegate after her name. If the delegate is a Past Madam President, write her name and put a **D** and **P.M.P.** after her name. Now after the delegates list the alternate and add **A** after her name (do not give the alternate any votes). Now skip two lines and then list **ALL** the “alive” Past Madam Presidents or Ten Year Secretaries (TYS), even if they do not plan to attend the Convention. Many times they will change their mind, and unless listed on the credential sheet, she may lose her vote.

Example: Members on which State Per Capita Tax has been paid **388** as of June 30, 2021 (This means number of members on your rolls **NOT** including Dual Members) Total Auxiliary Votes **16** (You will note that in the sample this Auxiliary only used **9** of their **16** votes losing 7 votes)

All three (3) credential sheets must be identically filled out with the Auxiliary **SEAL** on each and mailed to Debbie Newman, Registration - 1237 Grove Point Dr., White Lake, MI 48386 **PLEASE DO NOT WRITE IN THE CREDENTIAL NUMBER COLUMN**, as this column is for the State Secretary's use in assigning the delegate credential numbers. **Do not enter the Grand Aerie ID number in this column.**

NOTE: A sister that receives her Gold Card prior to the State Convention **IS** considered a Past Madam President and should receive her PMP vote – the same for a sister that receives her Gold Card prior to State Convention that she is a Ten Year Secretary (TYS).

NOTE – Our State Madam President appoints the Convention Committees from the Credential Sheets, so please mail it back to the State Secretary prior to **April 13, 2022** so a copy may be given to her.

NOTICE: Late changes in Auxiliary Delegates, or Alternates, must have a letter from the Auxiliary Secretary to present to the Credential Committee at the Registration Desk. **The Auxiliary Seal must be affixed to the letter.**

MEMBER PRE-REGISTRATION – This form is used for registering members that are coming to the Convention that are not delegates or a Past Madam President.

MEMORIAL SERVICES – The Joint Aerie and Auxiliary Memorial Service will be held on Thursday, June 9, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Great Hall.

SESSIONS – the first Michigan State Auxiliary Session will begin on Thursday, June 9, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. **SHARP.** All sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m. **SHARP.** Sisters, please remember that we have a dress code for our sessions. **NO SHORTS, HALTER TOPS, SPANDEX or ATTIRE ABOVE THE KNEE** is permitted and the Guards at the doors will enforce this.

REGISTRATION – Delegates Registration is **\$35.00** and Banquet tickets are **\$30.00**. Each Auxiliary must allow their accredited Auxiliary Delegates, expenses over and above registration and banquet tickets. **Please make out separate checks for the Delegate Fees and the Banquet Tickets.** All checks should be made payable to **Michigan State Auxiliary, F.O.E. Convention Fund and must be an Auxiliary check; and signed with three signatures.** Send to Debbie Newman, Registration along with the Delegate sheets and the Banquet Ticket Reservation form. **SEND ALL THREE (3) COPIES OF THE DELEGATE SHEETS AND THE TICKETS RESERVATION FORM PRIOR TO APRIL 13, 2022.** One copy of the Delegate sheets is used by the State Madam President to appoint the Convention Committees, one copy is used by the Registration Committee and one copy is used by the Election Committee. **Please make sure all three copies are signed by the Madam Secretary with the Auxiliary Seal affixed.** Past Madam Presidents not wanting a Banquet Ticket may register for **\$35.00**, which includes a badge and a program book. A Member Registration is **\$35.00**, which includes a badge and a program book. A separate Member Registration sheet is enclosed. **A Past Madam President or Ten Year Secretary** is considered a delegate even if she is not a delegate sent by the Auxiliary this year.

BANQUET FORMAT- Banquet reservation form is included in this bulletin. Please return with a check or money order prior to **April 13, 2021**. This form is used for ordering tickets for your delegates as well as any visitors or guests that wish to attend. If your group wishes to sit together, we must receive the form and check together.

1. All tables will be assigned on a first come basis at the time of purchase and no changes can be made after the table is assigned.
2. The first ticket purchased will be a table #1, next Table #2, and so on.

It is very important to make sure that if you want to sit with someone in particular, you must purchase the tickets together. A designated person may pick up the Banquet Tickets at the Registration Desk. If a ticket is purchased for one's spouse or guest, be sure to indicate after that person's name the number of tickets that they are to receive. **NOTICE – THE MAXIMUM SEATING CAPACITY FOR THE BANQUET IS 350 PEOPLE PER VALLEY PLAZA RESORT – SO GET YOUR RESERVATION IN EARLY. REMEMBER THAT EACH AUXILIARY IS STILL OBLIGATED TO PURCHASE A BANQUET TICKET FOR EACH DELEGATE ALONG WITH THEIR REGISTRATION FEE IF SHE WISHES TO ATTEND THE BANQUET.**

RESOLUTIONS – If your Auxiliary has a resolution for the State Convention, please follow the proper procedure. The resolution must be passed by your Auxiliary at a regular meeting and signed by the Madam President and the Madam Secretary. It must have the **Auxiliary Seal affixed**. Please have the Resolution drawn up correctly and submit three (3) copies to the State Secretary no later than May 31, 2022. This will give the State of the Auxiliary Committee time to present them for consideration and refer them to the Resolutions Committee.

BY-LAWS – if your Auxiliary wishes to submit a by-law change for the State By-Laws, please follow the procedure of section 42.1 of the Rules and Regulations and Section 9.4 of the State By-laws and the suggest change must be turned into the State Secretary prior to May 22, 2022.

NOMINATION FOR STATE OFFICE – If you are nominating a sister from your Auxiliary to run for State Auxiliary Office, please write or call Patricia Murney, State Secretary for a form for your nominee to fill out and return with your letter of nomination. **This form is not necessary if she is a current serving State Officer.** Should your Auxiliary wish to nominate a sister from your Auxiliary for a State Auxiliary Office, send a letter of recommendation with her name and qualifications and the office to which she is seeking, if she is seeking a certain office. The Madam President, and the Madam Secretary, and a Past Madam President **MUST** sign the letter. Should your Madam President or your Madam Secretary be the one being recommended, then she should not write or sign the letter. A Past Madam President should sign in her place. The letter to the Nominating Committee should contain the date the motion was made on the Auxiliary floor for the approval of the Nominee **AND BE VERY SURE THE AUXILIARY SEAL IS ON THE LETTER.** No person other than a Past Madam President or a Ten-Year Secretary of a local Auxiliary shall be eligible for office in the State Auxiliary, and she shall be in good standing in her home Auxiliary. Nominations may be made from the floor at the State Convention Session with the nominating speech limited to three (3) minutes by a member of the Nominee’s Auxiliary. **REMEMBER** to use the Candidates legal name, the name on her Official Receipt, when placing her name in nomination.

ANY NOMINEE NOMINATED FROM THE CONVENTION FLOOR MUST BE NOMINATED BY A MEMBER OF HER OWN AUXILIARY.

ALL NOMINATING LETTERS MUST BE SENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO: - State Madam President, Clara Arnold, 1548 Montgomery Dr., Hartland, MI 48353, postmarked no later than May 31, 2022. Be sure to mark the envelope in the bottom left hand corner – **ATTENTION STATE NOMINATING COMMITTEE.**

NOTICE - DISTRICTS - PLEASE DO NOT send support or recommendation letters for a nominee for State Office, as the only letter that will be considered will be the one from the Nominee’s home Auxiliary by the State Nominating Committee.

RITUAL COMPETITION – All ritual Competition will be held at the Valley Plaza in Midland on Tuesday, June 7, 2022. To enter the Ritual Competition you must request the necessary entry forms from the State Ritual Coordinator, State Past President, Linda DesJarden or email her at ldesjarden@comcast.net she needs to know in advance, how many teams will be competing, so that she can do the necessary scheduling and notify the teams and individuals? All entries must be returned to the **State Ritual Coordinator** by May 1, 2022.

All Auxiliary members of the Ritual Team must be registered for the State Convention to enter competition per the State Auxiliary by-laws section 9.1a. And **All JUDGES MUST** be a registered Delegate to be a Judge in any and all Competitions.

REMEMBER - State Auxiliary by-laws section 9.1b states that all Michigan State Ritual & Drill units must enter competition at the State Convention to be eligible to enter competition at the National Convention.

Class "B" Team consists of 5 Ritual officers only

Class "B-3" Unit shall consist of any member in good standing in Michigan.

No Auxiliary may have more than two members on a team in this category.

"One Woman Class" – consists of one individual that does all of the Ritual chairs.

"Sure Shot" – consists of one Ritual officer wishing to compete in a different Ritual Chair then she competed in her team event. Her name will be placed in the hat for that office, which will be drawn by lot by the Ritual Coordinator and she shall notify you if you are competing or not.
